7/2006/5707 Bowkersteads. Seasonal camping use of agricultural field.
The site already has 35 pitches on a concealed site in the woods. However, these pitches cannot accommodate large family tents and so some agricultural fields were also used last summer. This application seeks permission for seasonal use of one field. It is not intended to increase numbers. The application was supported because:

 - It will contain and control the overflow of large tents.
 - The planting scheme will screen the site.

7/2006/5665 Old Breasty Haw. Two storey side extension, first floor extension, alterations to house, septic tank.
There were no objections, however, the following comments were made:

 - The driveway/car parking area should be surfaced with gravel not tarmac.
 - Some screening of the car park from the highway with vegetation would be beneficial.

park will be lodged. Also one for traffic calming measures where pedestrians cross the road.

- A directional road sign survey needs to be carried out within the parish.
- An additional shuttle bus will run from Hawkshead. It may have a trailer for bikes.

Action - Mr Gill and Mr Townsend to photograph all directional signs and complete the survey.
