Minutes of the Meeting of Satterthwaite Parish Council held in the Studio on Tuesday 24th February 2015.

119.1. Apologies for Absence: Councillor David Fletcher (SLDC commitment) and PCSO Emma Forrester.

119.2.i. Mr & Mrs Robert Fletcher circulated information sheets and expressed their concerns about the misuse of the road, at the junction by Hawkrigg House and Damson Cottages, as a car park.

RESOLVED: Councillors resolved to write to the parties involved and to work to create an off-road parking area. For the meeting scheduled for 24th March, councillors will prepare a draft proposal to put before residents, church and planners.
