## **Notes on the rebuilding of St Paul's Church, Rusland**

The chapel of St Paul, Rusland was built in 1745. According to Miss Skelton, who composed a poem about the building in 1843, it was a rude and humble building with lattice windows containing no stained glass. It was of low height and had a small tower at the west end. Surrounding it was a small, consecrated chapelyard used for burials.

By 1866 the chapelyard could accept no more burials and the building was in a poor condition. As St Paul's was about to become the Parish Church of Rusland, improvements were set in motion.

The nave of the old building was taken down to its foundations and rebuilt with stone-mullioned windows and a much higher roofline.

A chancel was added to the east, covering part of the chapelyard used for burials. One of the more influential families, the Twisadays of Thwaite Moss, apparently did not want a recent family tomb disturbed, and hence the southern wall of the chancel had a low arch added just above its foundations, spanning the grave and supporting the masonry above.

A vestry was built on the northern side of the chapel, again on top of earlier graves.

As the roofline of the chapel had been considerably increased in height, the tower had to have 15ft added to its top to keep the structure in proportion. One of the original windows can still be seen on the west side. To ensure the lower part of the tower could support the extra weight of masonry, it was encased in an additional wall of stone, and buttresses were added at the corners.

To make the rest of the chapel match the new design of the tower, buttresses were added at intervals along the length of the nave and the chancel, again covering some of the graves in the chapelyard.

The chapelyard was extended to the south and east by approximately ten yards, and to the north filled the area between the church and the highway.

## Compiling The Rusland Churchyard Plan, 2010.

### Terms

The 'original chapelyard' is as built in 1745.

The 'new churchyard' is as enlarged in 1866.

The 'present churchyard' is as enlarged in 2000.

The 'old register' is burials pre 1850.

The 'new register' is burials post 1850.

The 'old plan' is the existing graveyard plan with its amendments.

The 'new plan' is the 2010 version.

### Points to Note

1) The boundary walls of the original chapelyard are shown on the new plan by a dotted grey line. All burials before 1865 had to be within this dotted area. In the new register this means graves 1 to 122, so any numbers in this range marked on the old plan that fall outside the original chapelyard boundary are errors and have not been included on the new plan.

2) There was only one gate to the old chapelyard, at the northwest corner. The gate and path to the south did not exist.

3) The chapel/church was also enlarged in 1866. The chancel was built on the chapelyard, over a number of graves. The chancel east wall seems to have been designed to be just outside the original chapelyard wall so that no graves were disturbed, but the two sidewalls cut through the graves. It seems the Twisaday family objected to their family tomb being dug up, the solution being the arch in the south wall of the chancel. The vestry was also added, covering more graves. The buttresses are also mid-19<sup>th</sup> century additions, and at least one child's grave is under a buttress.

4) The 1851 O/S 6" map shows a building spanning the space between the tower and the west wall of the chapelyard. This building was at an angle to the tower, and some of the graves in the top south corner of the chapelyard took their alignment from this. Other graves aligned with the chapel or chapelyard wall, giving a confused layout in this part of the chapelyard.

5) The last 100 or so burials in the old register give the location of the graves, as the distance from the east wall of the old chapelyard, and either from the north wall, the chapel, or the tower, depending upon where the grave was situated. Where possible, these have been plotted on the new plan in salmon pink colour. The accuracy is probably +/- 2ft as the measurements seem to have been made by pacing across the ground. As the burials are not numbered in the old register, the numbers on the new plan are random and only for reference to the plan key, giving the surname and year of burial. From this, it should be possible to cross-reference details from the old register.

6) The old and new registers overlap by nineteen burials. Hence, most of these graves have both a number, and location details from the east wall etc as before. This means that grave numbers 3, 4, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 18 and 19 have been plotted from the dimensions given in the old register.

They do not match the positions marked on the old plan, where there are five places where grave 4 is marked, three places for graves 12 and 14, four places for grave 15, and two places each for graves 16 and 18. None of these match the old register dimensions, giving serious misgivings about the accuracy of the old plan.

7) Graves that have memorial stones and kerbs have been measured and added to the new plan. The names on some of the memorials do not match the grave numbers given on the old plan (usually one digit is different) and these have been corrected.

8) The memorial stones sometimes have two or three (or more) people mentioned on them. All the burial numbers of those mentioned have been included on the grave, although some of the burials are probably elsewhere.

9) Having plotted the old register graves and the visible memorials, the remaining grave numbers from the old plan have been added in the available spaces. Removing obvious transcription error, grave numbers 1-122 outside the original churchyard walls, and incorrect positions of graves 1-19, there are still multiple versions of grave numbers. These are marked \* on the new plan.
